In 1st half of 2021, Japan asked Twitter to remove more posts than any other country

Japan was the top requestor to Twitter Inc. to have online posts removed in the first half of 2021, the company said in a recent report. Removal demands from Japan made up 43% of all demands across the world.

Russia came in second after Japan, with 25% of global requests.

Globally, Twitter received 43,387 requests to remove content. The requests were court orders and other formal demands from governmental entities and lawyers representing individuals.

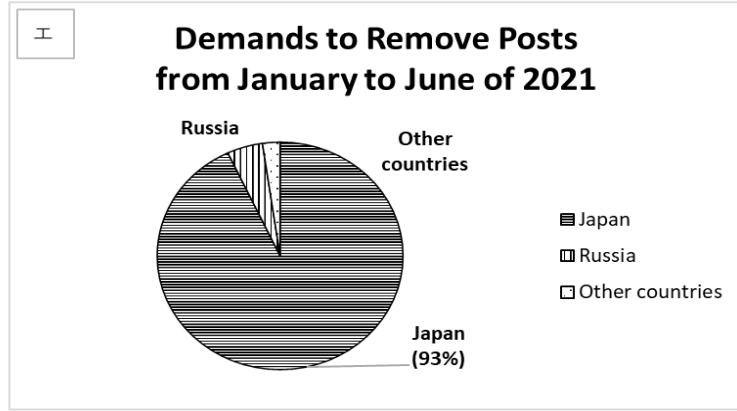
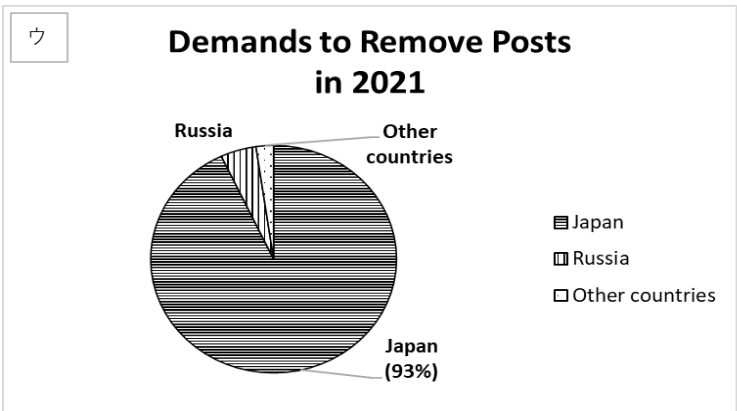
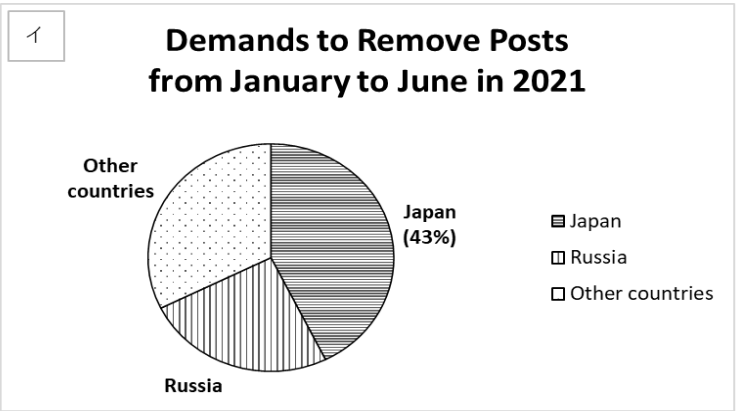
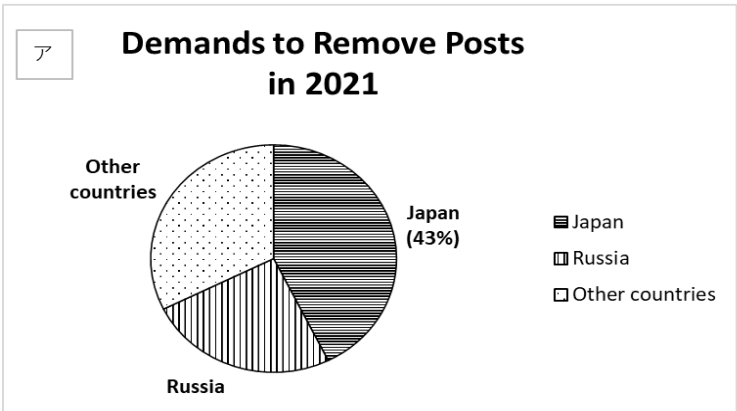
There were 18,518 requests from Japan.

The report said 93% of the requests from Japan were mainly related to laws concerning narcotics and drug control, obscenity, or financially linked crimes.

Legal demands are made when tweets violate local laws, among other cases. Twitter reviews the demands before deciding whether to comply.
